HOSPITAL SUPPORT

SEC Care provides quality support for clients who need to be in hospital due to illness or treatment.



SEC Care's qualified Community Support Workers can provide clients with the following pre and post hospital support services:

Transport Our friendly staff can meet you at take you to and from the hospital in a private car. A rate will be charged for any travel incurred.

Shopping for Essential Items As you may not have been home for a while, you may need to stop for milk, bread, medication or other essential items. Our friendly staff can assist you in shopping.

Settling back at Home We can assist with packing away essential items, making a drink or meal, or staying with you for up to a few hours after coming home from hospital.

Domestic Assistance You may need laundry washed, or domestic tasks undertaken so that your environment is comfortable, clean and inviting. We can assist you with any domestic assistance to ensure that your transition back home is as smooth as possible.



As of 1 January 2017, service fees are \$45.00 (+GST) per hour (or part thereof for shorter time slots), during the hours of 7:00am to 8:00pm, Monday – Friday.

Please note that increased fees will apply outside these hours, depending upon availability.

In addition to an hourly rate, a reasonable fee will be charged to cover the cost of transport services.

The SEC Care Post Hospital Support service is designed to suit your individual needs and mobility level.
