Quality Community Care

SERVICES PROVIDED BY SEC CARE



Personal Care

SEC Care provides assistance to help clients with personal hygiene and daily self care tasks, such as showering and dressing.



Home and Garden Maintenance

SEC Care can provide assistance to access approved providers to facilitate garden maintenance and minor repairs.



Social Support

Social support is available to assist clients in getting out and about in their local community. Activities can range from dining out, attending local spectacles and events, to any other social activity the client may wish to do.



Foot Clinic

The SEC Care Foot Clinic is available to provide quality care and maintenance of feet – suitable for individuals unable to manage this task on their own.



Transport

Our transport service is available for eligible clients, for approved services, such as attending medical appointments.



Domestic Assistance

SEC Care provides domestic assistance to help clients with basic cleaning tasks in the home, such as vacuuming and laundry.



Community Nursing

SEC Care can provide home and clinic nursing to people of all ages.



Hospital Support

SEC Care provides quality pre and post hospital support for clients who need to be in hospital due to illness or treatment.



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Centre Based Care

Respite Care – Centre Based and In-Home

SEC Care Day Centres provide respite services and relief to carers by assisting them with the provisions of their caring role. In the comfort and care of SEC Care's qualified staff, clients have the opportunity to create new relationships and pursue hobbies in a safe and friendly environment.



Home Care Packages: Our government subsidised Home Care Packages assist people to remain happy and healthy in their homes. Under the Consumer Directed Care model, Home Care Packages are created with clients to suit their individual needs and goals. Home and Community Care (HACC) Services: At

SEC Care, we accept referrals for HACC services for people under 65. Eligibility for HACC services are directed and determined through or by Tasmania Carepoint (1300 769 699).

Community Home Support Program (CHSP) Services:

At SEC Care, we accept referrals for CHSP services for people over 65. Eligibility for CHSP services are through referral, which can be submitted through the My Aged Care Portal online at www.myagedcare.gov.au/referral or by calling 1800 200 422.

Veterans' Services:

DVA Nursing – Veterans are required to contact their General Practitioner for a referral to be provided with SEC Care nursing services.

Veterans Home Care – Veterans are required to contact VHC Regional Assessment Agency on 1300 550 450 for an assessment prior to home care services being provided by SEC Care.

Private Clients/Brokered Services: Brokered services and private clients are available on request. Services can be provided by SEC Care or via a contractual arrangement with other agencies.

The NDIS at SEC Care: SEC Care is registered with National Disability Insurance Australia to deliver a selection of quality services through NDIS.
