Since 2005, the Association has operated under the trading name of South Eastern Community Care (SECC).

Services are provided to frail aged and younger disabled members of the community including special needs groups for Non English speaking backgrounds, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent, rural and remote areas and financially disadvantaged clients.

Assistance is also available for post acute care, short term loan of equipment and referral to other appropriate support services.

Services are provided across regional, rural and remote areas of southern Tasmania including the municipal areas of Sorell, Clarence and parts of Brighton, Southern Midlands and Tasman.
